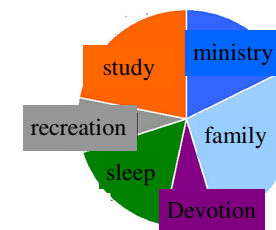
Too Many Pieces in Your Pie?

If our time looked like a pie, divided into the activities of our lives – how would yours look? What would the major pieces be? Mine would have slices of family, ministry, study, sleep, recreation and devotion to God, for a start. All good things, most would agree. And it is wise to fill our lives with good things and to be thankful for them.

However, sometimes even those things make us feel rushed and pressured for much of the time. Are there simply too many of them or have they become out of balance? A dietician recently pressed the point – what if one segment grows in its importance in our lives? The result is the others get squeezed and often suffer. This can begin a very unhealthy sequence of events in our lives – a domino effect causing devastation – especially in very full lives. We need to be watchful over the balance of our lives and heed early warning signs of stress and take action appropriately to fix the problem. Don't wait for others to do it for you – take control of your own life - with God's help of course.

Jesus came that we may have life and have it to the full (John 10:10). I don't believe that means so full of activity that we never stop. Jesus walked away from people and tasks when he needed to rest or pray. We have permission to do the same.
